Travel Instructions



All Travel opportunities have been suspended due to Covid-19

Requirements

- The applicant must have completed at least two years in the 4-H program.
- The applicant must have met all of the 4-H Year Completion Requirements in the previous year.
- The applicant must be an active 4-H member when he/she applies for the travel program and when he/she goes on the travel program.
- The applicant must be 16 years of age as of the start date of the conference. All conference details are on the pages that follow.
- Applicants are eligible to apply for ALL programs (age permitting). Please rank trip choice(s) where indicated on the application form. (If applicant has been on a National or International Travel Program before, he/she is eligible to apply for the same program again).
- Applicants may be chosen as a participant for more than one travel opportunity.
- Permanent employees of 4-H PEI are not eligible to apply for travel opportunities.

Instructions

- ✓ Selection criteria will be based on: Information included on Application, Reference Form, Topic of Choice, Interview Questions and a short Multiple Choice Quiz.
- ✓ Only one application form is required. Please use a pen with blue or black ink to fill out application (for photocopying purposes).
- ✓ Do not assume that information is known about you – use detail.
- ✓ The 4-H member is responsible for keeping a copy of his/her application form for reference and to assist with interview preparation.
- ✓ The member's topic of choice should be well thought out and will require preparation time. Members will be expected to speak on their topic for a minimum of 2-3 minutes. No cue cards or notes are permitted.
- ✓ Each applicant is expected to have a reference form completed and submitted by a person of their choice. This person should not be a family member, relative or friend. The reference form must be returned to the 4-H Specialist by the reference person via email or in a sealed and signed envelope. The 4-H member cannot submit the reference form to the Provincial Office on the individuals' behalf.
- ✓ Accommodations can be offered to members who may require assistance with the quiz or topic of choice due to a learning disability, or another medical reason, please let 4-H staff know in advance.
- ✓ Interviews will be scheduled for January – applicants will be notified of interview time. If applicant is unable to attend interview in person they will be expected to call in using Facetime, Skype, Zoom or another video option of the member's choosing. This must be arranged prior to interview day.

The annual US National 4-H Conference is the premiere civic engagement opportunity for 4-H members across the US.* One 4-H member, aged 16-19 at the time of travel, from each province forms the Canadian delegation. Conference delegates choose an important societal topic and in round table groups prepare a formal briefing. Briefings are presented to US federal officials around the Washington, DC area.

In addition to the conference activities, 4-H Canada delegates have a chance to tour Washington, visit some of the nation's famous cultural and political sites, including Lincoln Memorial and Capitol Hill, and visit the Canadian Embassy.

*4-H Canada participation in this program is subject to annual invitation from the US Organizing Committee.
